**Jason Williams** currently serves as Utility Enterprise Operations Manager for the San Jacinto River Authority, a public agency created by the legislature in 1937 for the purpose of developing, conserving, and protecting the water resources of the San Jacinto River basin. Jason provides overall management of treatment, production, and distribution of potable water from Lake Conroe to various large volume users including The Woodlands Township. He also manages wastewater collections and treatment at three wastewater treatment facilities serving 11 Municipal Utility Districts in Montgomery County, Texas. Prior to his appointment to Utility Enterprise Operations Maintenance Manager, Jason served as the SJRA Woodlands Division Operations and Maintenance Manager.

Prior to coming to SJRA, Jason worked in municipal public works for the City of Cleveland. He has more than 25 years' experience in private sector operations and maintenance in the water and wastewater fields.

Under Jason's management SJRA's plants have been recognized numerous times as Plant of the Year by the Water Environment Association of Texas and have also received performance awards from the National Association of Clean Water Agencies for outstanding commitment to wastewater treatment, state of the art controls and operations, and service professionalism.

Jason currently holds a TCEQ "A" Water and Wastewater license.
