

Lieutenant Scott Spencer

Lieutenant Scott Spencer is in his 24th year in law enforcement and began serving as Lieutenant in the Administrative Division on January 1, 2017.

Prior to this assignment, Lieutenant Spencer served as the commander over the newly created Montgomery County Narcotics Enforcement Team (MOCONET), which was a High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Initiative (HIDTA). This included the interagency liaison of law enforcement officers from local, state and federal law enforcement agencies. Lieutenant Spencer was responsible for sensitive investigations and operations involving the pursuit and arrest of high valued narcotics traffickers. This Task Force consisted of specially trained law enforcement officers who were skilled at high level narcotics trafficking investigations utilizing covert operations to target narcotics traffickers.



From May 2009 through March 2015, Lieutenant Spencer served as a Task Force Officer for the DEA Major Drug Squad Federal Task Force. This Task Force consisted of specially trained law enforcement officers who were skilled at high level narcotics trafficking investigations. During his tenure there, Lt. Spencer completed numerous investigations that resulted in the indictment, arrest and subsequent conviction of numerous persons involved in trafficking of narcotics, money laundering and firearms. These investigations were conducted not only locally, but nationally and internationally.

From March 2008 through May 2009, Lieutenant Spencer, served as a Detective with the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division. In that capacity, Lieutenant Spencer was responsible for the coordination and investigation of numerous large scale burglary and theft investigations that resulted in significant seizures and numerous arrests in Montgomery County and surrounding counties. These investigations resulted in the arrest and conviction of persons involved in burglary "rings" as well as the recovery of hundreds of thousands of dollars in personal property.

Lieutenant Spencer joined in the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office in 2009 after spending the previous 9 years working as a patrol officer, then sergeant with Conroe Police Department. During his tenure at the Conroe Police Department, Lieutenant Spencer was assigned to Criminal Investigations, Patrol, Bike Patrol and Special Events coordinator for the Conroe Police Department.

Lieutenant Spencer is a 2016 award recipient of the United States Attorney Award for his work in federal narcotics cases. Lieutenant Spencer is the recipient of the 2017 100 Club Hero Award. Lieutenant Spencer has received Special Recognition Awards in 2005 and 2006 from the Conroe Police Department. Lieutenant Spencer also is the recipient of the Conroe Police Officer of the Year award in 2002 and in 2004. Lieutenant Spencer received a U.S. House of Commendation-Kevin Brady-2004 as well as the Salvation Army Hometown Hero Award in 2001 and a Meritorious Service Award from the Conroe Police Department-2004.

Lieutenant Spencer is a graduate of the FBI-LEEDA Leadership Training, a 2019 Graduate of Leadership Montgomery County and a 2020 graduate of LEMIT-Leadership Command College.
