HISTORY

- Founded in 1987 by the Conroe Chamber as Leadership Conroe.
- In 1995, The Woodlands Area Chamber of Commerce joined together with the Conroe Chamber to form LMC.
- The alumni group started in 1999.
- Additional chambers joined as partners in the program.
- Presidents of the chambers served on the board, appointed board members, and rotated chairmen.
- LMC became an independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization in 2005 and moved to a board-appointed board of directors, selected by a nominating committee each year.
- More than 1,000 business and community leaders have graduated from the program since its inception.
- The Montgomery County Leadership Summit was added in 2022 bringing leadership development training to the entire community.
- The Leadership Master Class, a next level leadership program for LMC graduates was added in 2022.
